FIVE MINUTE GUIDE: FLORENCE

- . ABOUT: Nestled in the foothills of the Chianti mountains, the first thing to notice about Florence is the orange glow coming from the city's rooftops that makes the whole place radiant. Florence was the birthplace of the Renaissance movement that's so shaped its gorgeous architecture, pastelcolored walls, hanging shuttered windows and immaculate churches. No wonder the entire city center is listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, When the sun sinks towards the horizon, be sure to catch a glimpse of the city from the River Arno that runs through the town; you're unlikely to forget it anytime soon.
- EAT: Expect simplicity and quality at the Fattoria Rossi Firenze in Piazza dei Davanzati. Choose from hearty plates of hams, Mediterranean vegetables and regional cheeses with a selection of organic wines to accompany it all. Produce comes directly from the owners' farm, where sustainable farming is the order of the day. Outdoor seating available for sunny days.
- DRINK: Take a seat on an upturned barrel and sample the flavors of Tuscary at wine bar Vini E Delizie in Via dei Banchi. Choose one of the local bottles that line the walls or opt for one of the bar's

- classic cocktails, such as an Aperol spritz. The small plates of delicious spreads and dips will be sure to keep you there for hours.
- STAY: For a quintessential stay in Florence, look no further than the beautiful Hotel David. Set in a former 19th-century mansion that still contains all the original antique furniture, this elegant and cosy residence will make you feel at home, especially as it has a limited number of individually decorated rooms to choose from. Enjoy an iced drink in the leafy garden or grab a book and sink into an armchair in the lobby. Breakfast is included.
- . VISIT: There's no sight in the world quite like Piazza del Duomo. Located in the heart of the city's historic center, it's where you'll find the exquisite Florence Cathedral (Santa Maria del Fiore). The exterior of the cathedral itself is a work of art and has the largest brick dome roof ever constructed. The square is also home to other famous landmarks such as Giotto's Campanile, a giant bell tower, and the Florence Baptistery, one of the oldest buildings in the city, with a mosaic octagonal dome. Visit at night, when these famous three sites are lit up with floodlights, for a truly spectacular view.
